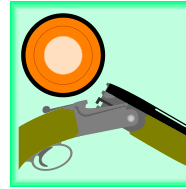

Pl.T.A. & W.R.E.T.A. rules will govern this shoot. Any violation of assigned yardage will be cause for forfeiture of all prize money and trophies, so don't cheat. HRSC and the Hood River Elks Lodge #1507 will not be responsible for lost or stolen property, so keep an eye on your stuff. The management reserves the authority to reject refund or disqualify any contestant who interferes with conduct, accuracy, sportsmanship, karma, or is hanging around the cashiers window to see if their score is going to hold up. Likewise, the management may exercise the right to change and or modify this program in whole or in part any way we damn well see fit to.

True flying Caldwell or White Flyer targets will be thrown on professionally maintained pat traps with voice releases. Targets will be set at daylight and will be reset only by the W.R.E.T.A. target setting committee if necessary.

To qualify for added money and/or team buckles at the Grand, a shooter must be an elk member and shoot at least 6 Sunday events in the 2010 season.

We are sad to announce that Wreta has cancelled the magnum option. We at Hood River being on top of new trends have decided to offer shooters the best of a magnum option and the best possible payoff. We are offering a "modified magnum" option. Anyone breaking 50 straight in either preliminary handicap event 1 or 50 straight in event 4 handicap will receive 100% of the modified magnum on that day. If there are two 50's they will split the entire pot. This is a double pay vs the old "magnum" If there is no 50 straight shot on the first event, 25% of entire daily pot will be paid to the top handicap score- or scores if there is a tie who played the option. The pot will then carry over from Saturdays to Sundays handicap. If there is no 50 shot in the handicap on Sunday, again 25% of the pot will be paid to the top finisher(s) who played the option. This option is only available on Wreta handicaps.

Example:

Saturday 60 shooters enter @ \$5.00 = \$300.00 to perfect 50. No 50 shot- top placing option player paid 25% of \$300.00 = \$75.00

Sunday 100 shooters enter @ \$5.00 = \$500.00 + Sat pot \$225.00 = \$725.00 no 50's again- top playing option shooter will receive 25% of \$725.00 = \$181.25

Carry over to 2011 Hood River Wreta shoot will start at \$543.75 on Saturday's handicap.

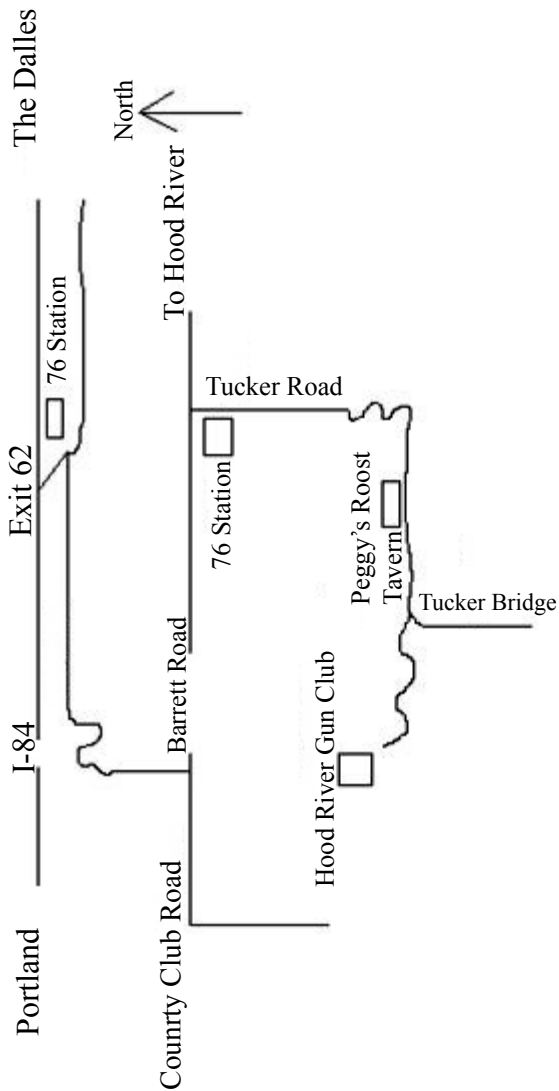

Important shoot info that you had better pay attention to

Start time on Sunday is 7:30 a.m. Don't sign up on the first squad if you can't make it. We are trying to cut down on man hours of running late on Sunday. Be here, be ready! Since many shooters seem to read our programs with a fine tooth comb, most will notice that we have added a review of guns for Sunday - Vets and Super Vets only! 10.00 entry- 1:6 pays 70/30 buyer shooter. Three cal's at lunch will be a handful, so we will start with the Vets cal first, then the ladies cal, then the main cal. The cal's will start around when the 3rd to the last squad takes the line to shoot singles. So check the board and see when you will be sold, if your shooting in the last 3 squads feel free to mark a maximum bid on the board by your name and the shooters who you wish to make a bid on if you do not have a buddy to bid for you while shooting. We are trying to minimize the long cal lunch downtime. The super raffle will contain something super. The tickets will be pick and stick, check the board to see what your prizes are. Make sure you write your name on your tickets!
